 - i. Budget situation is not ideal
 - ii. Received just about same (if not less) funding as we did last year, which is difficult for us to do all of the things we want to do in student activities
 - iii. Less budget allocations is not us picking on you, it is simply because there is less funding (<50% of normal funding is available in this year's budget)
- d. Travel
 - i. Many are already thinking about and putting in travel proposals, but currently we are suspending travel for the year for a number of reasons:
 - 1. Predominantly, it is because CUNY says we cannot travel for the year with COVID-19 still in place (domestic travel i.e. anything outside of the 5 boroughs is suspended)
 - 2. Also because we do not have the budget to support student travel, need to make sure budget is allocated to most amount of people
 - 3. Also because we do not have enough staffing to support travel
 - ii. Question: what counts as domestic travel within the 5 boroughs?
 - 1. Answer: depends on context
