Services We Do Not Offer

- We do not do pre-implantation genetic diagnosis for cosmetic traits!
 Sorry!
- We do not pressure to abort fetuses likely to be born with nonfatal disabilities. Instead, we promote education about quality of life. (Of course, abortion always remains an option)
- We do not encourage implantation of multiple embryos! That's just too risky for the fetus and the person carrying it.

How Do YOU Feel About Donor Anonymity?

We will match you with a donor who feels the same way! It's YOUR choice, not ours. Intended parents who want access to their donor's identity will be matched with a donor who is comfortable providing such information. Intended parents who prefer their donor remain anonymous will be matched with an anonymous donor.

Assistive Reproductive Technology shouldn't be available only to the wealthy! It should be available to everyone who wants it, just as reproduction via sexual intercourse is available to anyone able to conceive that way. Patients who have demonstrated financial need will receive services free or at reduced

Having Babies Isu't Just For Straight People

We welcome lesbian, gay, bisexual & transgender people, and accommodate the unique reproductive needs of queer and trans patients. We provide access to legal information related to same-sex parenthood (such as one parent adopting their own child) so that patients are best equipped to advocate for their families. We have a strong working relationship with reproductive rights advocacy groups and LGBTQIA+ advocacy groups, in order to ensure that our patients have access to people who will defend their rights in court.



We Represent Disabled Individuals

At Ms. Conception, you can select FOR your disability in your child. If you are deaf or have dwarfism, for example, you have the option to choose an embryo with the same trait. We also advocate for thorough and accurate education about disability to parents of potentially disabled

Are You Considering Donating Your Eggs?

Here are some things you should know!

- All donors must submit medical records, in order to prevent hereditary diseases
- All donors will be compensated the same amount, regardless of education
- All donors will meet with a counselor and a medical professional before being approved, in order to ensure full understanding of the process of egg donation
- All donors will have access to free counseling
- Donors may choose whether or not they wish to be anonymous
- Donor health will be monitored even after the donation is complete



Ms. Conception Takes a Stance Against Eugenics

We recognize the horrific history of eugenics in the United States, and its unavoidable links to reproductive technology. This is why we have a firm policy against the use of pre-implantation genetic diagnosis for anything other than hereditary diseases and selecting for non-fatal disabilities. We would never allow for forced or coerced sterilization, and we do our best to stress informed autonomy at every juncture.

We hope to empower all types of people to make the reproductive choices that are best for them, especially the many who currently have limited access to Assisted Reproductive Technology. This includes disabled individuals, LGBTQIA+ individuals, and people below the poverty line.
