International Advocacy

NYC Fertility has partnered with countries that have become hubs for International surrogacy. We're hoping to make sure of is that every woman understands the procedure and implications of surrounding surrogacy, and the goal of this partnership is allow for greater informed consent but also address some large scale issues on a community level. We advocate for addressing the root of why some of these women are seeking procedures, that being high levels of poverty.

Our clinic is working towards giving women access to quality education by establishing partnerships between international and local governments, nonprofits, and community members. With these partnerships better schools will be established and hopefully aid these women with a long term solution as a opposed to a short term solutions such as surrogacy.

For women who are informed about the implications of of surrogacy and feel empowered by the process, we are working towards de-stigmatizing them within the community by educating members about what ART is and how it works and the amazing things it can do once all parti
